PREFACE

After some research in the Allegany County Courthouse records, the General Index to Miscellaneous Instruments (Vol. A to J and Vol. K to Z) was found and it was in those two volumes that the canal boat mortgage records were found. The data have been compiled in twenty different documents, one for each of the principal mortgagees; usually boat builders but not always. If a reader is searching for an ancestor with his or her name and/or boat name, this index is offered as the place to start. There were a few women boat buyers and boat captains. After the record has been found, then the applicable compilation will provide details to the mortgage. Do note that some boats were mortgaged more than once and in the early 1880s particularly, owners occasionally used their mules with harness and boat rig as collateral for a loan and the document mentions the canal boat on which the mules were working, even though the canal boat was not part of the collateral.

This index does not include all the mortgages in the compilations; mortgages for personal property, saw mills, town lots, &c. were deleted to concentrate on the canal related items. The deleted items remain in the several compilations for the benefit of family history researchers.

There is also a continuing search for the correct spelling of names of people and boats. Readers are encouraged to read the referenced mortgages as their time and interest permits. Feel free to send observations and corrections for the benefit of other readers.

There was no mortgage to Thomas Hassett in Book 11, page 64; it was only in Book 14, page 64, from the Cumberland Coal & Iron Co.
