
Committee developed the budget for 2021. We reorganized it somewhat to make it easier for responsible parties to track. We did see one significant savings. We can reduce the number of inserts in the newsletter. The inserts cost \$300-400 each. The Finance Committee will monitor the budget on a regular basis.

The anticipated deficit for 2021 is \$8,670, highlighting the need for a dues increase. The proposed revision to the bylaws will empower the board to raise the dues. The Finance Committee will monitor the budget on a quarterly basis. Assuming the revision to the bylaws is approved

The committee feels that the membership dues need not cover the entire cost of *Along the Towpath*. There is a lot of content (history, nature, etc.) not related to association business. This content is that part of our broader mission.

Jon Wolz performed a reconciliation of the Association's fund balances over the past several years. He will use the Treasurer's reports to update the fund balance every two months. The balances are shown on the following pages.
