

**President's Report**  
**Annual meeting, March 2022**

**Seneca Aqueduct**

There is a committee forming to advocate for the restoration of Seneca Aqueduct. Jon Wolz and Rod Mackler are involved in the group. They contacted the Association about the possibility of using us as a collection point for their donations. They wanted to take advantage of our 501(c)(3) status.

The committee's sense of urgency has decreased because the park plans to conduct structural engineering analyses of all aqueducts. Jon has reported that the Seneca Aqueduct group will remain fairly quiet until the park's structural engineering report is complete in 1½-2 years.

**Cumberland ranger**

The Association provided 70% funding for a guide position in Cumberland from April 2021 through March 2022. Our intention was to provide this funding for three years if all went well.

Unfortunately, the employee left in December 2021. The park is in the process of filling the position. The Association has agreed to provide 70% funding for a second. We agreed to make the donation and sign the agreement once the new employee reports for duty.
